FRIDAY – 11/9/18

- 7:00 am **Depart Immaculate Conception Church**, 400 Saratoga Road, Glenville, NY (rear parking lot). We will be making a stop on the way down.
- 3:00 pm **Arrive at Best Western Plus Intercourse Village Inn & Suites** (717) 768-3636. Rated awesome, the Inn features an indoor pool, fitness center, restaurant and free Wi-Fi. It's also located across the street from Kitchen Kettle Village!
You'll have time to freshen up before we leave for dinner and show or take a quick dip in the pool.
- 4:10 pm Bus departs promptly for **Hershey Farm Restaurant** where you will enjoy a grand all-you-can-eat smorgasbord . . .one of the best Lancaster has to offer! After you eat, spend time browsing in their gift and bake shop.
